

## DAY 1: PRAY FOR 'EYES TO SEE'

As we begin a fortnight of prayer, united as a church, let's pray that over the next 14 days we will comprehend new revelations that will release answers to our prayers.

"I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better."

Ephesians 1:17

Father, we thank you for wisdom and revelation. As we step into this season of prayer and fasting, open the eyes of our hearts so we can know you better and enlarge our capacity to receive the things we ask for.

## DAY 2: PRAYER OF THANKS

Today we offer thankfulness for all the blessings around us and for the answer to the request we have made. When we water the seed of our faith with thanks, it grows.

"...give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."

1 Thessalonians 5:18

Father, I thank you that you are the source of all blessing. Thank You for your faithfulness throughout my life. I thank you that in every circumstance, you are working for our good and that answers are on the way.

## DAY 3: PRAYING FOR HEALING

Praying for healing and health is our inheritance. Jesus took to the Cross all our infirmities and our sicknesses. Today, let's pray for everyone believing for healing and for divine health and for a healing revival.

"He [Jesus] was beaten so we could be whole. He was whipped so we could be healed."

Isaiah 53:5

Father, we thank you for the Cross that broke the power of darkness. We ask for healing to flow to all who need it. We speak your resurrection life and power over every body that needs your touch.

## DAY 4: PRAY FOR PROVISION

God designed us for abundance. Our inheritance promises that we would 'be blessed to be a blessing'. Let's pray for our families and our churches to flow in Kingdom abundance.

"For God is the one who provides seed for the farmer and then bread to eat. In the same way, he will provide and increase your resources and then produce a great harvest of generosity in you. Yes, you will be enriched in every way so that you can always be generous."

2 Corinthians 9:10

Father, we thank you for abundance. Thank you that there is always more than enough for our every need. Provide according to your riches in glory. Help me to be a testimony of your goodness and a source of your generosity.

# FOURTEEN *days of* PRAYER & FASTING

## DAY 5: PRAY FOR NEEDS

We know that God is our Father and that He loves to take care of us as His children. In the story of the prodigal son, we learn that He qualifies us as his heirs. Let's pray for answers and for breakthrough, both personal and corporate.

"What is the price of two sparrows—one copper coin? But not a single sparrow can fall to the ground without your Father knowing it...So don't be afraid; you are more valuable to God than a whole flock of sparrows."

Matthew 10:29-30

Father, we thank you that we are your beloved children and heirs. We thank you for houses for every family that needs one, and for jobs for those who are asking. Lord, we thank you for cars, bonuses, buildings, connections and opportunities to break out on every side.

## DAY 6: PRAY FOR OUR LEADERS

Today we pray for all who lead across iSEE CHURCH in these roles. The Apostle Paul requested prayer in Eph 6:19, saying: "And pray for me, too." One way we can honour our leaders is to pray for them.

"Dear brothers and sisters, honour those who are your leaders in the Lord's work. They work hard among you and give you spiritual guidance. Show them great respect and wholehearted love because of their work."

1 Thessalonians 5:12-13

Father, we thank you for those who serve among us, especially those you have called to labour as ministers of the Gospel. We speak favour, blessing and wisdom for them and their families.

## DAY 7: PRAY FOR MISSIONARIES

Today, let's pray for those who have taken the Gospel to the world. It is our honour to pray for our missionaries and to agree with heaven's plan to reach the nations with God's Love.

"And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"

Romans 10:14

Lord, thank you for everyone who has gone out in your name. Bless them abundantly. We speak favour and wisdom over them. Also Lord, send even more labourers into the world so that people everywhere will know your love.

## DAY 8: PRAY FOR MIRACLES, SIGNS AND WONDERS

We are in a Supernatural Season and are thankful for everything God has done to date. And now there is more! Believe today for your miracle, open the eyes of your heart to the signs and the wonders that Holy Spirit is revealing in our lives.

“Go and announce to them that the Kingdom of Heaven is near. Heal the sick, raise the dead, cure those with leprosy, and cast out demons. Give as freely as you have received!”  
Matthew 10:7-8

Father, we thank you for the releasing of the supernatural in our lives and our congregations. I receive Your anointing to carry this Holy Spirit power into my day. Release miracles, signs and wonders through me.

## DAY 9: PRAY FOR SALVATION

The Bible clearly reveals that God loves the world. And for this reason He sent Jesus to make it possible for people to know Him. Let's pray for everyone we know that needs to find Jesus.

“This is good and pleases God our Savior, who wants everyone to be saved and to understand the truth. For there is one God and one Mediator who can reconcile God and humanity—the man Christ Jesus.”  
1 Timothy 2:3-5

Lord, thank you for saving me. Thank you that I have a testimony of Your love. Give me an opportunity to share it today. Father, we thank you for a harvest of souls. We ask for people to be born again in our homes and in our churches. Help me to share the gospel with grace and zeal.

## DAY 10: PRAY FOR VICTORY

The enemy has been defeated and today we pray for the manifestation of that victory in our lives. Let's speak the name of Jesus over fear, sin, trouble and debt. What a privilege it is for us to be administrators of the authority Jesus won for us.

“For every child of God defeats this evil world, and we achieve this victory through our faith. And who can win this battle against the world? Only those who believe that Jesus is the Son of God.”  
1 John 5:4-5

Father, we thank you for the Cross. We announce victory for the poor, the brokenhearted, freedom for the oppressed and sight for the blind. The Spirit of the Lord is on me to release victory in Your name.

## DAY 11: PRAY FOR OUR KIDS

Children are part of our inheritance. Today we pray the promises of God over our children, whether they are yet unborn, living at home or far away. The Bible says that in the last days the hearts of the Fathers will turn to the children so let's ask God how we as parents can show His love to our kids.

“All your children will be taught by the Lord, and great will be their peace.”

Isaiah 54:13

Father, thank you for our children. We ask that children will be born into believing families. We agree with heaven that our children belong to you and ask that each one.

## DAY 12: PRAY FOR FAMILIES

Our families are often a mission field and provide opportunities to demonstrate God's love. Let's speak salvation, favour and peace over our households and believe for each one to be filled with the Spirit.

“Repent and be baptised, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off...”

Acts 2:38-41

Father, thank you for our families, for those who live in our homes and our extended families also. We believe that each one is loved by You and that their is a wonderful destiny for them. We ask for them to experience grace today, to be filled with your Holy Spirit, healed and delivered in Jesus name.

## DAY 13: PRAY FOR YOUR CITY AND NATION

All believers carry a measure of heaven's authority. Jesus taught us to pray: “Your Kingdom come and Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.” Do not underestimate the power of your voice to declare the dreams of heaven. The psalmist wrote: “Ask me, and I will make the nations your inheritance, the ends of the earth your possession.”

“Also, seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have carried you into exile. Pray to the Lord for it.”

Jeremiah 29:7

Father, I thank you for my city and this nation. Today we pray blessing, peace and favour over it. We ask that Your Kingdom would come especially to the churches in our city and that Your will would be accomplished through our prayers.

## DAY 14: PRAY FOR REVIVAL

Today we pray for times of refreshing to break out across our nation and in the world. As Ezekiel was asked to prophesy according to what he was shown, we also prophesy revival because we know from the scriptures that God has promised times of refreshment will come from the presence of the Lord. (Acts 3)

“For as the waters fill the sea, the earth will be filled with an awareness of the glory of the Lord.”

Habakkuk 2:14

Lord, we echo the heart of heaven and ask today that you would pour Your Spirit out and release times of refreshing in our homes, our churches and across the world. Lord, everywhere that there is a witness of Your grace we ask that for a Holy Spirit outpouring. Let every church become a well of Your Spirit, drawing out living water for eternal life to whosoever comes. We pray for healing revival, manifestations of the Spirit and an abundance of people to know the gift of salvation and power.
